Lessons:

Deuteronomy 23:19

- 1. If you are hurting a fellow brother or sister in Christ, you need to stop. The worst kind of hurt we can do is to hurt those in the body of Christ. We are to be an army, an army that prays for one another, helps one another, and encourages one another. We ought not to be hurting one another.
- 2. Sin against our brothers and sisters in Christ needs to be confronted with the goal being repentance.
- 3. Leadership takes courage. Christian leaders need to confront sin head-on.
- 4. Leadership involves being a good example, and showing the way.
